Seeking Assistance in times of ...

Mobilization, deployment, natural disaster, mass casualty, acts of terror and other significant events that impact the local military community at large are the focus of this program's assistance. This is done in a variety of ways, but primarily these three:

1. Family Assistance Center (FAC) capabilities
2. Soldier Readiness Processing
3. Training and Education

Family Assistance Center

In the event of a significant event, the Garrison or Installation Commander can activate the Family Assistance Center. This act centralizes essential family assistance services physically and ensures operating hours are adjusted appropriately between "normal" hours to 24 hours if necessary. Here at Fort Sill, we are fortunate to have the one stop center at Bldg 4700. For the most part, activating the family assistance center would primarily involve extending operating hours.

Also, the capacity to provide services off the installation may be necessary depending on the limitations imposed on access to the installation. In case an off post site would be needed the public will be made aware through various media outlets.

Soldier Readiness Processing

When units deploy from Fort Sill, Soldiers complete a Family Assistance Information Sheet. These sheets are processed through the Mob Dep program and a matrix of identified potential issues is provided to command to ensure awareness of issues and assistance is offered to those families.

Ultimately, we at Fort Sill want to ensure that Soldiers and Families are taken care of, thereby increasing readiness.

ACS offers many trainings that are available and applicable to FRGs. Two main areas are for the FRG Leadership and the FRG Membership.

Training and Education for Leadership

Every month, on the 4th Wednesday a topic is presented for FRG Leaders, key positions, Commanders, Rear Detachment Commanders and Family Readiness Support Assistants. All of these groups are encouraged to attend all of the trainings in an effort to build the team by increasing understanding in all areas. The topics rotate quarterly so they are offered multiple times throughout the year and include:
