SUBJECT: Trinity Christian Academy Board Meeting on 11 January 2011 at 1800

1. The meeting was unofficially called to order at 1800. 3 Board members were present, 5 were absent. One Board Member led an Invocation.
2. The Principal, Darrell Nightingale, gave a report over the number of students currently enrolled in the school, 90 students. He also spoke on the Geography Bee that was held on the 7th of January. The winner is going to take a test to try to advance to regionals. The Archery team is competing at MacArthur Middle School on the 29th of January. The school is having the Children of the World Choir come and perform on the 4th of Feb. The school's teachers and Board members are housing the children while they are here. Mr. Nightingale expressed that the pancake breakfast was a success and raised \$1,600 dollars.
3. The Meeting was officially called to order at 1815. 5 Board members were present, 3 were absent.
4. The Board approved the minutes from the December Board meeting. They also approved the monthly financial review. In the financial review, it was reported that after fundraisers, tuition and donations the school had \$4,466.21 dollars in the bank.
5. There was 1 item of old business concerning Harvest Church of Plenty but it was tabled.
6. In new business, the Board spoke on the Pancake Dinner being successful and that the Beef jerky fundraiser being run by the PTF now. The tickets for the Mark Shultz concert are now online at the new TCA website. They are also thinking that if the concert is a success they will look into a Fall Concert.
7. The Board spoke at great length about adding a 9th grade or staying with 8th grade and below. They had a motion and a second but were withdrawn and the Board decided to pray over it for one more month. The Board did decide to have a summer school program for K-3, K-4 for 20 students and have a waitlist for more if they can get the staffing.
