MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: 2012 Fort Sill Intramural Skeet Shooting Memorandum of Instruction

1. PURPOSE.

This memorandum, IAW USAFCEFS PAM 215-1, prescribes the procedures and rules for conducting the 2012 Fort Sill IM Skeet Shooting.

2. GENERAL.

- a. The 2012 Fort Sill IM Skeet Shooting will be scheduled as follows:

3. ELIGIBILITY and TEAM COMPOSITION:

- a. IAW USAFCEFS sports program letter, only active duty military personnel assigned or attached to Fort Sill on official orders are eligible to participate
- b. Participation is unlimited. Only the top two shooters out of each brigade will advance to the post championship on 28 April 2012. Brigade may organize with the skeet range personnel to shoot at their own convenience when the range is open to determine who will represent their respected brigade. Individual weapons may be used, or the skeet range will have weapons for use for this competition.
- c. Each shooter will need to have 200 shots fired prior to 26 April 2012. Each shooter may shoot all 200 shots at one time or shoot 25 or 50 at a time but must complete the request 200 shots prior to 26 April 2012. Total number of hits will determine who will advance to the post championships. Teams can be mixed gender. Each brigade must report who their shooters will be by COB 26 April to the Sports Office.

4. CHAMPIONSHIP SKEET SHOOTING:

- a. Post Championship will take place on 28 April each shooter will have 25 shot shoot off to determine the skeet shoot champion of Fort Sill. A combine score of both shooters will determine which brigade will win the Commanders Cup points for the brigade.

5. AWARDS:

- a. Individual's awards will be given to the top two finishers of the championships. Team trophies will be award to the top two combine shooters for their brigade.
