MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: 2012 Fort Sill Intramural Volleyball Memorandum of Instruction

1. PURPOSE.

This memorandum, IAW USAFCOEFS PAM 215-1, prescribes the procedures and rules for conducting the 2012 Fort Sill volleyball season.

2. GENERAL.

a. The 2012 Fort Sill Volleyball season will be scheduled as follows:

<u>Entry (LOI) Suspense</u>	<u>Coaches Meeting</u>	<u>Start Date</u>	<u>Post Championships</u>
Tues 20 Mar 2012	Thurs, 22 Mar 2012	Tues, 27 Mar 2012	29 May – 1 Jun 2012

b. The coaches meeting will be held at 1130 hrs on 22 Mar 12 at the Rec Plex, Bldg 2502 on Sheridan Rd, Fort Sill.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

a. IAW USAFCOEFS PAM 215-1, Para 7, page 3.

b. Participation is unlimited.

c. Teams are limited to a roster of twelve (12) members.

4. LEAGUE RULES:

a. Play will be conducted IAW 2012 United States Volleyball Association (USVBA), unless amended by this MOI.

b. The Sports Branch will provide game balls and equipment necessary for conduct of volleyball games.

c. Time limit of one (1) hour is imposed.

d. League play will be dependent upon number of teams registered. Teams will be divided into equal division.

e. Team will be limited to twelve (12) players

f. In each division, players may participate with only one team. If a player is transferred to another MAC/BDE after league organization, he/she may choose to play with the newly assigned team, or the original team, not both.

- g. Rosters are not required for open league play. Team coaches are required to ensure that all players meet eligibility requirements.
- h. Volleyball officials will conduct a pre-match conference prior to the start of each match. The pre-match conference will include, but not limited to the following:
 - (1) Discussion of ground rules.
 - (2) Lineup cards. Each team coach will provide one lineup card for the official scorer of the match. All players who may be used during the match must be listed on the lineup card prior to the start of each match. All players must provide their legal given name for the scorer.
- i. Matches winners will be determined by a best two (2) of three (3) games per match. The first two games will be played to twenty-one (21), must win by two (2) points. The third game will be played to fifteen (15), must win by two (2) points.

5. LEAGUE PLAY:

- a. IAW USAFCOEFS PAM 215-1, Para 10, page 5.
- b. League play will be dependent upon the amount of registered teams. Teams will be divided into equal divisions.
- c. The scheduled starting time is considered forfeit time.
- d. If a tie in league standings, at the end of league play, exists and has an effect upon the Championship Tournament seeding, the tie-breakers are as follows.
 - (1) Head-to-head play
- e. Every effort will be made to provide each team with as many games as possible.
- f. Every effort will be made to ensure that each team has the comparable amount of games.

6. POST CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT:

- a. IAW USAFOCES PAM 215-1, Para 19, page 12.
- b. The Post Championship Tournament will be a single elimination format.

7. POSTPONEMENT and FORFEITURES: IAW USAFCOEFS PAM 215-1, Para 11, page 6.

8. EQUIPMENT and UNIFORM:

- a. Sports Branch will provide game balls and equipment necessary for conduct of volleyball games..
- b. No shorts with pockets are permitted, (safety reason), NO EXCEPTIONS.
- c. No jewelry or watches may be worn during play.

9. PROTESTS: IAW USAFCOEFS PAM 215-1, Para 13, page 7.

10. CONDUCT and PARTICIPATION: IAW USAFCOEFS PAM 215-1, Para 14, page 8.

11. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- a. During league play, the manger or coach is responsible for ensuring that:
 - (1) All members of the team are familiar with the contents of these by-laws.

- (2) The team is fully equipped and properly attired.
 - (3) The conduct of the team is IAW USAFCOERS PAM 215-1
12. POST TOURNAMENT: Top two teams from each brigade will participate in the post championship, if only one team from a brigade is participating in league play they will go to playoffs automatically since there the only team from that brigade.
13. AWARDS: Awards will be presented to the members of the 1st and 2nd place teams competing in the Post Championship Tournament. Team awards will be presented to the Championship and Runner-Up Team.
